The Dangers of Delivery Vehicles



Delivery vehicles are a common sight on our roads. They bring packages, food, and supplies to homes and stores every day. While they are helpful, delivery vehicles can also be dangerous. Because they are commercial vehicles, they are larger and heavier than most cars. When a crash happens, the injuries can be very serious..

One danger comes from the size of delivery vehicles. These vehicles are taller and longer than regular cars. This makes it harder for drivers to see people, bikes, and small cars around them. Blind spots can hide a child crossing the street or a cyclist riding nearby. If the driver does not see them in time, a crash can happen. Another risk is driver fatigue. Many delivery drivers work long hours and have tight schedules. They may feel rushed to make every stop on time.

Tired drivers can make mistakes. They may react slowly or fail to notice

traffic signs and signals. Even a small mistake can lead to a serious accident.

Delivery vehicles also stop often. They may park on busy streets or block bike lanes. This can force other drivers, walkers, and riders to move into traffic. Sudden stops and quick turns can surprise other drivers and cause collisions. Poor vehicle care is another concern. Some delivery vehicles are on the road all day, every day. If brakes, tires, or lights are not checked often, they can fail. Mechanical problems can make it hard for a driver to stop or steer safely.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Tessa's Super Yummy Cream Puffs

- 1 sheet frozen puff pastry, thawed
- 1 package mousse mix (Vanilla recommended, but any flavor works)
- Fresh berries (optional, but they make them extra pretty)
- Powdered sugar for dusting or melted chocolate for drizzling

PREPARATION

Preheat the Oven to 400°F

Position a rack in the center.

Line a baking sheet with **parchment**.

Lay out the thawed puff pastry. Cut into shapes using your preferred cutter.

Bake for 15 minutes, until lightly golden on top. Do not open the oven. Watch closely so they don't over-brown. Transfer to a wire rack and let them cool completely before filling.

Prepare mousse according to package directions. Wash and slice berries if needed.

Split each cooled puff pastry horizontally. Fill the bottom half with a few tablespoons of mousse

Replace the top. Dust generously with powdered sugar. Add a small dot of mousse and a berry on top for decoration.
